Addenda as of Apr. 1, 2021

## The Rules:

**2.2 Sample Units (clarification):** For the second Note: (at the top of pg. 3), this is generally ONLY true of infantry units. Artillery units particularly do not follow this rule.

**2.5 Die (clarification):** A "0" is a result of 10.

**5.2 Stacking (clarification):** Soviet SU-76 and AA units are considered Artillery type units for stacking.

**15.1 German Setup (correction):** The control marker should be placed in area 63 (not 64).

**15.3 Soviet Set Up (correction):** The 316th and 320th RDs should have a "(4/3)" unit identification.

## The Charts:

**Bombardment (omission):** The table is missing the "+" sign beside the 20 entry on the column. So there is a max of 20 APs per Fire combat.

## The Counters:

Note: Corrected counters for all of the below are included in all copies of ATO issue #36.



### Soviet Corrections:

The Soviet 306/155 and 627/180 should have an NATO Artillery symbol on their fronts instead of Infantry.



### Axis Corrections:

The fire combat factors of the 22 SS Cavalry units (17, 52, 53) on the back side of the larger strength counter should be "5" instead of "3".
